ECHUCA

When you come to Echuca, below is where you need to go and what is happening and when:

Scrutineering & spares truck: 10am—2pm

Your first port of call will be scrutineering, so head to here first.

Car Park at Echuca King Pin Bowl, Annesley St.

Registration & check in; 10am—2pm

After you have been scrutineered, you can then proceed to registration across the road in the Workers & Services Club. Please come through check in with your whole crew if possible. Here you will be given all your books, name badges and also do your final tally up with CF. Merchandise is also available to purchase.

Compulsory Crew Information Briefing; 2pm

All crew members, back up crews and officials must attend a pre-event briefing. This will take place at the Workers & Services Club.

Mobile Street Parade; 3pm

After the briefing, all cars are to head to Rotary Park to line up for the street parade. Be there, ready to leave by 3pm. It is important to note that while it is a parade & we will begin in convoy, all road rules apply. Stop signs, traffic lights, roundabouts etc... Make lots of noise and gain plenty of attention. Please don't throw any lollies etc.. out of your car. They will land in dangerous spots & kids will run into danger trying to get them. Hand them over, but don't throw them randomly.

Welcome dinner

Doors will open to the welcome dinner function at 6pm, ready for a 6.30pm start. It will be at the Workers & Services Club.

Tuesday morning start & breakfast

BATEMANS BAY FINISH FUNCTION

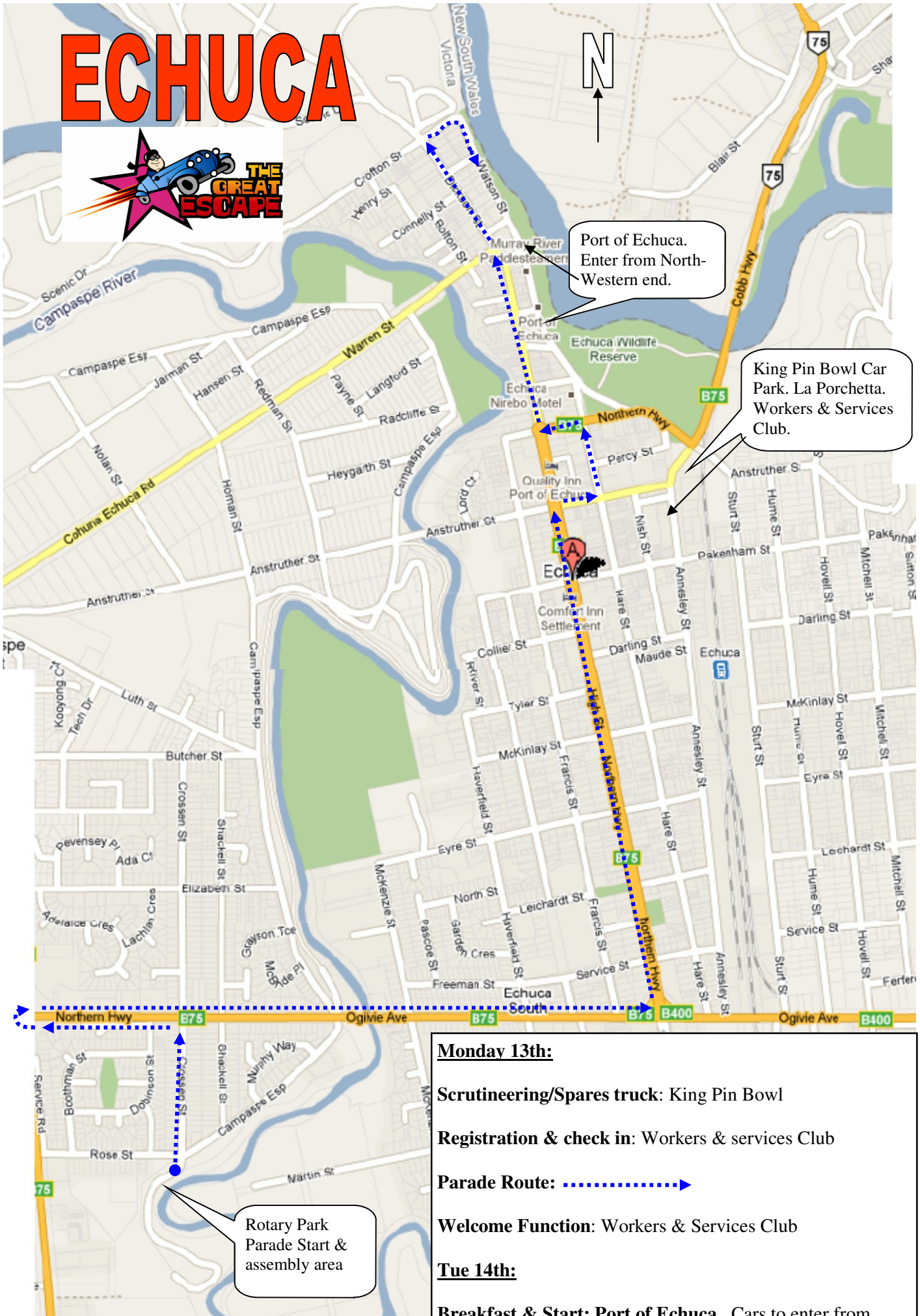
The finish line in Batemans Bay will be at 12pm at Corrigans Beach.
